



Ski Team Sweden ROLL Cup 2013

Swedish Ski Association with organizers invites all Roller ski-friends to the first edition of Ski Team Sweden ROLL Cup – the national Swedish Roller ski cup.

The purpose of the cup is to promote the sport of Roller ski and cross country skiing during the summer.

Races: The cup contains five race and all of them are counting in the total cup. The lady and man with highest points after the final race win the total cup.

Event dates:

29 of June Stockholm 2-3 of August Idre 22 and 24 of August Trollhättan

Classification:

The cup is open for ladies and men senior. Juniors can also participate.

Distance/ See the schedule below or each organizers **Technique:** website.

Entry: Each organizer is responsible for the entry to their event. See respective organizers website.

Calculation of points:

According to the FIS World Cup scale:

1st place = 100 points	16th place = 15 points

The cup is open for foreign participation – the single events as well as the total cup.

If several athletes receive the same number of points in the final classification the following rules are applicable:

- 1. Highest numbers of victories.
- 2. The athlete with the highest numbers of second-, third places and so on is placed before.
- 3. If the athletes still have the same number of points the price is shared between the athletes.
- Prices: At the events the organizers are responsible of the prices.

In the total cup the total amount of price money is 75 000 SEK – distributed as follows: (same amount for ladies and men):

1st place 15 000 SEK 2nd place 8 000 SEK 3rd place 6 000 SEK 4th place 4 000 SEK 5th place 3 000 SEK 6th place 1 500 SEK

Swedish Ski Association (Ludvig Remb) is responsible for the payment of price money.

Price money are paid to the athletes ski club or own business.

Wheels:

Roller ski races are conduced primarily on racing wheels but each organizer is allowed to have limitations for the wheels. If there is limitations the organizer have to inform about it and have to provide skis with similar wheels to the seeded athletes and wildcards.









Please respect the organizers wheel limitations – there will be controls of the wheels.

- **Safety:** All athletes *must* use covering helmet (bicycle helmet) and goggles with shatterproof glass in all events.
- **Seeding:** The top 20 men and top 10 ladies in the overall cup will be seeded to all events. In addition to the seeded group each organizer can provide any number of "wildcard" depending of the start field.

For the first event the seeding for 20 men and 10 ladies is based on the valid FIS distance list.

The seeded field are starting in an own row in front of the rest of the field in all mass start events.

In the sprint event 20 men and 10 ladies are seeded to the prolog in first place according to current WC standing in sprint and in the second place according to the valid FIS sprint list. The rest of the start list will be created with a draw.

Other information:

Other information about each event can be found on the organizer's website (se the addresses in the end of this invitation).

If an event is postponed the new organizer has the right to charge 50% of the original entry fee in a new entry fee according to the rules of the Swedish Ski Association.

If an event is cancelled the organizer refund 50% of the entry fee according to the rules of the Swedish Ski Association.

The sprint event in Trollhättan is conducted as a knockout-sprint according to the ICR 2012.

All organizers have the right to invite both international and national athletes to the events.
